Dr. James "Jim" Eales joined the Department of Agricultural Economics as a faculty member in 1994. He earned his B.A. in Economics with a minor in mathematics from California State University-Sacramento and was also selected as a Regents Fellow. Jim earned his M.S. and PhD. in Agricultural Economics from the University of California-Davis (1979-1983) where he graduated with honors.

Eales taught many courses during his tenure at Purdue including but not limited to quantitative techniques for firm decision making, econometrics, economics of agricultural markets.

Eales won the Outstanding Graduate Faculty Award, Department of Agricultural Economics, University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign, in 1990 and the Publication of Enduring Quality from the American Agricultural Economics Association in 2004.
